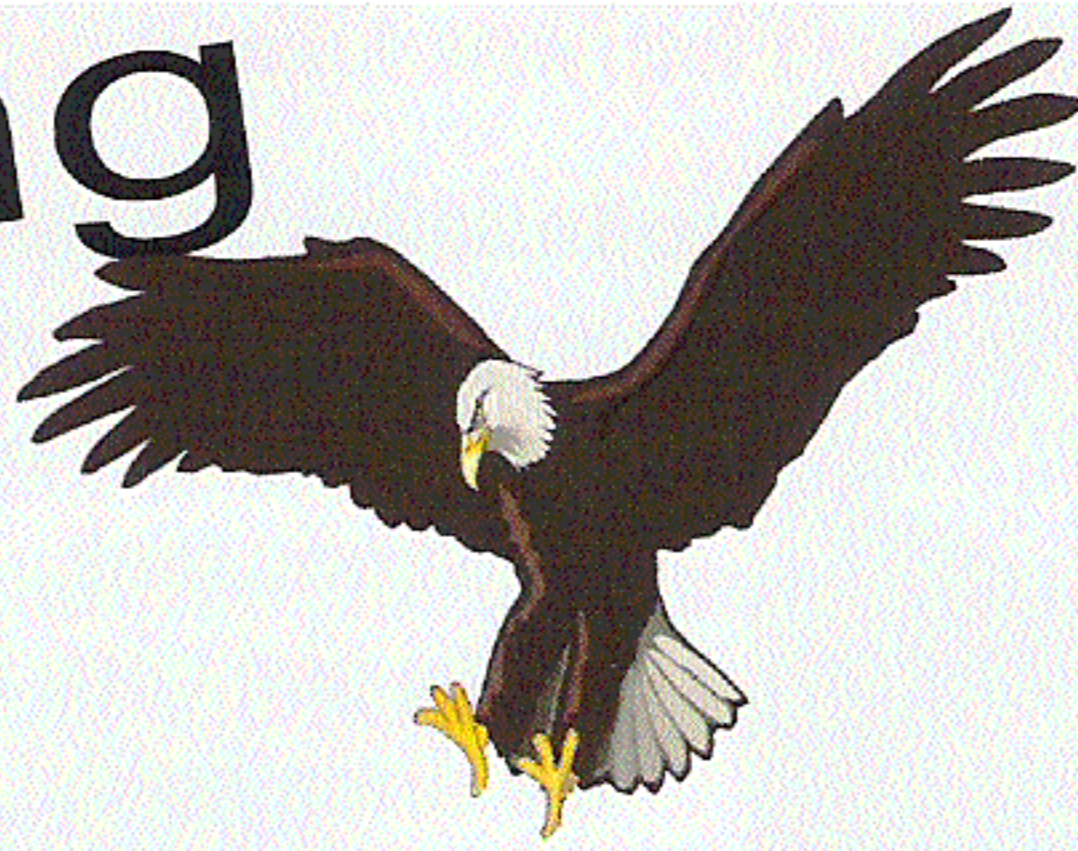

It is great to be home this summer to see all my family and friends. I have been busy in my garden, and also cleaning up 5 months of dust that has accumulated in my house while I have been in Haiti...

Things were a bit unstable when I left for home. There was quite a bit of rioting in several parts of the country. The UN Troops that are there to try to keep peace were unable to keep things under control. One thing the people were unhappy about was the lack of progress in the new government. The end result was that the Senate fired the Prime Minister and all of the other government Ministers that had been appointed by the President to help him run the country. Also causing riots were the increases in the prices of everything. Gas there is now about \$7.00 per gallon, and many food prices have doubled. Because of the rioting in the streets, the UN was unable to deliver the supplemental food which was a very tragic situation for the Haitian people. While we were pleased that there was no rioting in Cap Haitien, there were riots about 15 miles away. I hope things will be calm when I return to Haiti in September.



My home is already turning into a warehouse with the things that have been donated for Haiti. If you would like to come help me pack these donations, please let me know. We need things ready for shipping the first week in September.

The next two months here in Michigan will keep me busy with speaking engagements. I am scheduled to speak in a different church every Sunday until time to return to Haiti plus there are many events during the week. It all keeps me busy, but I am always happy to share information about Haiti.

I really appreciate everyone's support and help during the past year. We could not do what we do without you! Thanks so much.
